MINIMUM BASIC OPERATIONS TO REOPEN COSMETOLOGY/BARBERS/SALONS

Effective April 24, 2020



Temperature Checks - Must be conducted. Consider using a touchless thermometer for employees and patrons of the shop.



Client Screening Questions - Before entry into the shop, ask the client the following:

- Have you had a cough?
- Have you had a fever?
- Have you been around someone with these symptoms in the past 14 days?
- Are you living with someone quarantined?
- Store entry shall not be permitted for those with a fever or exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms.



Limit Clients in Shop - Services must be by appointment only. If clients are waiting, have them wait outside if possible. Only allow entry for those being served.



Maintain Social Distancing - Maintain at least 6 feet between workstations. Consider staggered stylist schedules and adding divider shields between workstations.



Use of PPE and Best Industry Sanitation Practices - Require employees to use masks and possible face shields. Require clients to wear masks / provide masks for clients. Do not re-use caps, smocks, gloves, or towels between clients. Wash hands between clients.



Disinfection - Businesses must be thoroughly sanitized each day. Sanitize workstations and common surfaces between each client. Avoid the use of cash or touch pads and pens to point of sale. Remove unnecessary magazines, newspapers and service menus.



Administration - Sick employees must stay home. Owners/managers should provide appropriate written and verbal training on additional health safety measures. Ensure common areas are thoroughly cleaned and sanitized.
